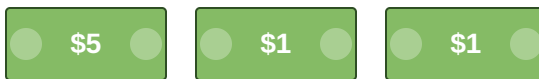

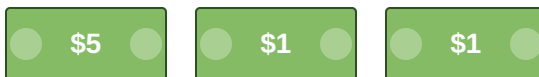
Read each problem and write the answer on the line.

- (4) Lily raked leaves for 6 dollars. Her friend paid her 3 dollars to water plants. How much money did Lily earn?

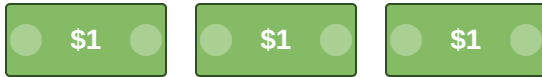


- (5) Tom helped his neighbor carry groceries. He earned 10 dollars. He saved 4 dollars. How many dollars did Tom spend?

- (7) Ben helped his dad in the garden. He earned 5 dollars. His grandma gave him 5 dollars for his birthday. How much money does Ben have?

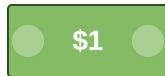
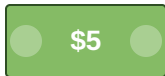




(8) Chloe sold her old toys. She earned 11 dollars. She put 1 dollar in her piggy bank. How many dollars does Chloe have left?
