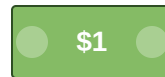
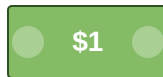
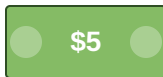
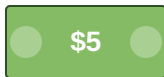
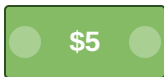
Read each problem and write the answer on the line.

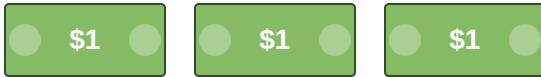




- (3) Sam earned 15 dollars for walking his neighbor's dog. He spent 6 dollars on a new toy. How many dollars does Sam have left?

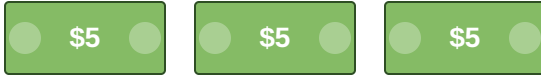

- (7) Ethan delivered newspapers and earned 11 dollars. His friend, Olivia, earned 6 dollars for helping her dad. How much money did they earn together?

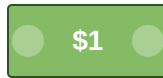
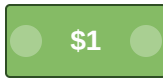
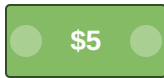


- (8) Grace earned 14 dollars for washing windows. She spent 5 dollars on a new book. How many dollars does Grace have remaining?
