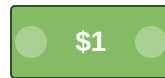

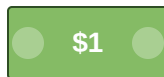
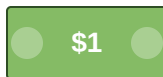
Read each problem and write the answer on the line.

- (7) Daniel earned \$18 helping his dad paint the fence. He used \$5 to buy a new toy. How much money does Daniel have left?

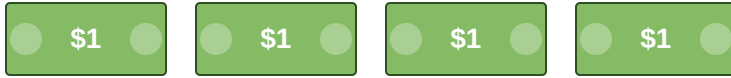


- (8) Emma helped her grandma in the garden and earned \$9. Her brother, Noah, earned \$6 for sweeping the porch. How much money did they earn together?
