Read each problem and write the answer on the line.

Add up what is spent, then subtract from the starting amount to find what is left.

- (1) Sarah received \$150 for her birthday. She decided to allocate \$60 for new art supplies, \$35 for a fun day at the amusement park, and save the remaining amount. How much money did Sarah save?

- (2) David earned \$200 from helping his neighbors. He plans to spend \$75 on new books, \$40 on a ticket to a soccer game, and put the rest into his savings account. What is the total amount David will save?

- (3) Maria has a budget of \$180 for the month. She has already spent \$50 on groceries and \$25 on school supplies. If she wants to put \$60 into her savings, how much money does she have left for entertainment?

- (4) Ethan's weekly allowance is \$40. He always puts \$15 into his savings. If he spent \$12 on a movie ticket, how much money does he have left for other fun activities?



(5) The school fair raised \$300 for new playground equipment. They decided to use \$120 for swings, \$80 for a slide, and save the rest for future maintenance. How much money did they save for maintenance?

(6) Olivia has \$250 from her summer job. She plans to spend \$90 on new clothes, \$65 on concert tickets, and allocate the remaining funds to her emergency savings. How much will Olivia put into her emergency savings?

(7) Mr. Henderson budgeted \$500 for his family's weekend trip. They spent \$180 on accommodation and \$110 on food. If they also spent \$75 on souvenirs, how much of their budget remains?

(8) Sophia earned \$120 by selling handmade cards. She decided to donate \$30 to a charity, spend \$45 on art supplies, and save the rest. What amount did Sophia save?

(9) Liam has \$75 to spend on his pet. He bought a new toy for \$18 and special food for \$27. If he wants to save any leftover money, how much will Liam add to his savings?



(10) A community group raised \$400 for a local park project. They spent \$150 on plants and \$90 on new benches. They plan to use \$100 for a picnic area. How much money is left for other park improvements?
