- (4) David has 4 dimes and 3 nickels. His sister, Mia, has 1 quarter and 2 dimes. Who has more money and by how much? 👧 👦



- (5) A toy car costs 60¢. John has 2 quarters, 1 dime, and 3 pennies. Does he have enough money to buy the toy car? If yes, how much money will he have left? 🚗
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
