



Adding and Subtracting Common Denominator Fractions

Add or subtract the fractions.

Read the sign carefully! + means add the tops, - means subtract the tops. Always keep the bottom number the same!

Example: $\frac{2}{5} + \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\quad}$ Ans: $\frac{3}{5}$ Solution: (add numerators: $2 + 1 = 3$)

(1) $\frac{1}{5} + \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\quad}$

(2) $\frac{1}{4} + \frac{3}{4} = \underline{\quad}$

(3) $\frac{1}{6} + \frac{5}{6} = \underline{\quad}$

(4) $\frac{7}{8} + \frac{3}{8} = \underline{\quad}$

(5) $\frac{3}{8} + \frac{3}{8} = \underline{\quad}$

(6) $\frac{4}{5} + \frac{4}{5} = \underline{\quad}$

(7) $\frac{1}{6} + \frac{1}{6} = \underline{\quad}$

(8) $\frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{4} = \underline{\quad}$

(9) $\frac{5}{8} - \frac{1}{8} = \underline{\quad}$

(10) $\frac{4}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\quad}$

(11) $\frac{2}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\quad}$

(12) $\frac{2}{3} - \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\quad}$
