Find the missing fraction.

Example: $\frac{1}{2} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 2$ Ans: $\frac{3}{2}$ Solution: ($2 = \frac{4}{2}$, so $\frac{4}{2} - \frac{1}{2} = \frac{3}{2}$)

(1) $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + \frac{3}{4} = 5$

(2) $\frac{3}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(3) $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + \frac{4}{5} = 3$

(4) $\frac{3}{4} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 4$

(5) $\frac{1}{4} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(6) $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + \frac{1}{8} = 5$

(7) $\frac{1}{4} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 2$

(8) $\frac{7}{8} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(9) $\frac{5}{6} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 2$

(10) $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + \frac{1}{5} = 2$

(11) $\frac{1}{6} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(12) $\underline{\hspace{1cm}} + \frac{3}{8} = 2$
