Find the missing fraction to complete the whole.

Example: $3 \frac{1}{3} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 4$ Ans: $\frac{2}{3}$ Solution: $(4 - 3 \frac{1}{3} = \frac{2}{3}$ needed to reach 4)

(1) $5 \frac{3}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 6$

(2) $4 \frac{7}{8} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(3) $5 \frac{1}{2} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 6$

(4) $4 \frac{1}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 5$

(5) $5 \frac{3}{8} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 6$

(6) $2 \frac{1}{6} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 3$

(7) $6 \frac{3}{4} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 7$

(8) $6 \frac{4}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 7$

(9) $6 \frac{1}{6} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 7$

(10) $7 \frac{3}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 8$

(11) $2 \frac{1}{2} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 3$

(12) $5 \frac{1}{5} + \underline{\hspace{1cm}} = 6$
