Let's count U.S. money in these questions!

Example: If you have 1 quarter, 2 dimes, and 1 nickel, you have $25¢ + 10¢ + 10¢ + 5¢ = 50¢$. So, you have 50¢.

- (1) Sarah has 2 one-dollar bills, 2 quarters, and 3 pennies. How much money does she have? 💰



- (2) Tom has 5 dimes, 2 nickels, and 8 pennies. How much money does he have?

- (3) A small toy car costs \$1.75. David has 1 dollar bill, 2 quarters, and 5 dimes. Does he have enough money? 🚗



(4) A juice box costs 80¢. Emily pays with a one-dollar bill. How much change should she get? 🥤

(5) Olivia has 3 quarters and 1 dime. Mark has 2 quarters and 3 nickels. Who has more money? 🤔

(6) Grandma gave Lily 1 five-dollar bill, 1 dollar bill, 3 quarters, and 2 nickels. How much money did Lily get? 📦
