Find the missing number for equivalent fractions.

Example: $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{\quad}{10} \rightarrow 2 \times 5 = 10, \text{ so } 1 \times 5 = 5 \rightarrow \text{Answer: } 5$

(1) $\frac{1}{5} = \frac{\quad}{10}$

(2) $\frac{1}{5} = \frac{\quad}{15}$

(3) $\frac{3}{4} = \frac{\quad}{8}$

(4) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{\quad}{6}$

(5) $\frac{3}{5} = \frac{\quad}{15}$

(6) $\frac{1}{3} = \frac{\quad}{15}$

(7) $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{\quad}{6}$

(8) $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{\quad}{12}$

(9) $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{\quad}{8}$

(10) $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{\quad}{12}$

(11) $\frac{3}{4} = \frac{\quad}{16}$

(12) $\frac{1}{5} = \frac{\quad}{25}$
