Find parts of groups.

Example: $\frac{2}{3}$ of the 12 balloons popped. How many popped? 8 balloons ($12 \div 3 = 4$, so $4 \times 2 = 8$)

(1) $\frac{1}{3}$ of 15 apples are red. How many apples are red?

(2) $\frac{2}{4}$ of 20 toys are cars. How many toys are cars?

(3) $\frac{1}{2}$ of 14 shirts are blue. How many shirts are blue?

(4) $\frac{1}{4}$ of 28 pencils are sharpened. How many pencils are sharpened?

(5) $\frac{1}{5}$ of 25 birds flew away. How many birds are left?



(6) $\frac{3}{6}$ of 30 candies were eaten. How many candies are left?

(7) $\frac{3}{4}$ of 16 books are new. How many books are old?

(8) $\frac{1}{5}$ of 40 cars are red. How many cars are NOT red?
