Solve for the unknown number.

Use inverse facts to find the missing number. Example: $\underline{\quad} \div 7 = 8 \rightarrow 56 \div 7 = 8$; $56 \div \underline{\quad} = 8 \rightarrow 56 \div 7 = 8$.

Example: $\underline{\quad} \div 7 = 8 \rightarrow 56$ | $56 \div \underline{\quad} = 8 \rightarrow 7$ | $\underline{\quad} \div 9 = 11 \rightarrow 99$

(1) $4 \div \underline{\quad} = 1$

(2) $70 \div \underline{\quad} = 10$

(3) $8 \div \underline{\quad} = 2$

(4) $8 \div \underline{\quad} = 4$

(5) $\underline{\quad} \div 10 = 4$

(6) $\underline{\quad} \div 10 = 5$

(7) $\underline{\quad} \div 5 = 5$

(8) $\underline{\quad} \div 6 = 3$

(9) $\underline{\quad} \div 10 = 3$

(10) $18 \div \underline{\quad} = 9$

(11) $50 \div \underline{\quad} = 10$

(12) $\underline{\quad} \div 8 = 6$
