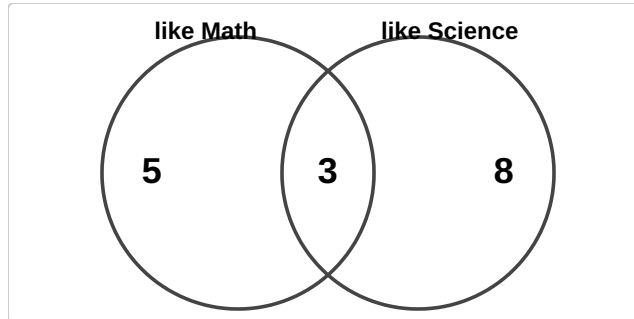

Interpret the Venn Diagram to answer questions.

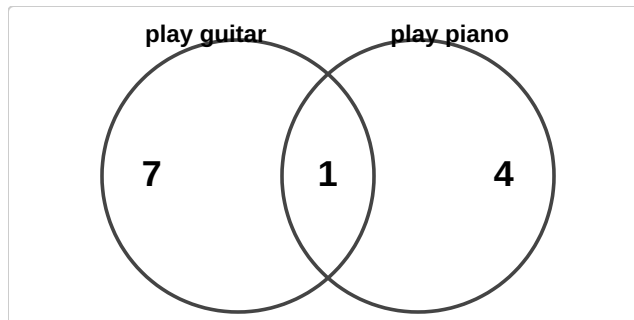
The diagram below shows which sports students play.

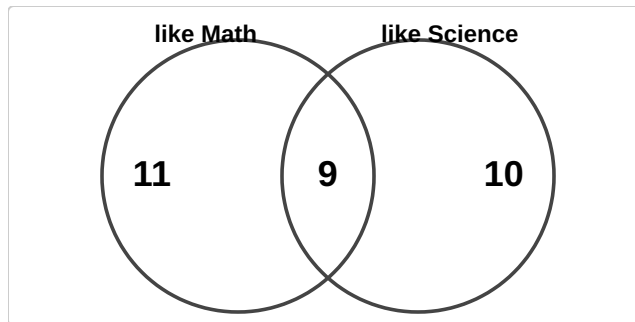
- (2) In a survey, 8 students play guitar and 5 students play piano. 1 do both. How many students are in "play piano" only?

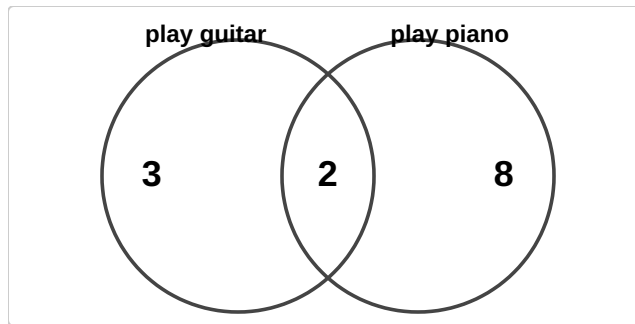


- (3) In a survey, 20 students like Math and 19 students like Science. 9 do both. How many students are in both groups?

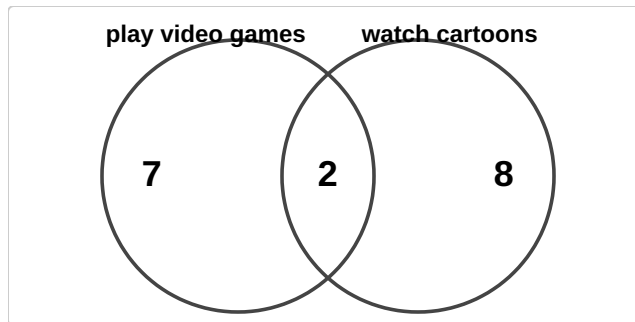
- (4) In a survey, 5 students play guitar and 10 students play piano. 2 do both. How many students play guitar?

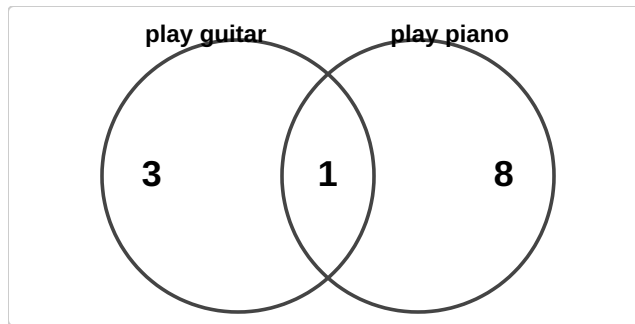


- (5) In a survey, 9 students play video games and 10 students watch cartoons. 2 do both. How many students watch cartoons?
