- (4) Write the number: 1 thousand, 3 hundreds, 3 tens, and no ones.
- (5) Write the number: 8 thousands, 3 hundreds, 5 tens, and 4 ones.
- (6) Write the number: 9 thousands, 5 hundreds, 4 tens, and no ones.
- (7) Write the number: 7 thousands, 6 hundreds, 9 tens, and 8 ones.
- (8) Write the number: 7 thousands, 6 hundreds, 3 tens, and 3 ones.
- (9) Write the number: 2 thousands, 8 hundreds, 5 tens, and 2 ones.
- (10) Write the number: 1 thousand, 1 hundred, 4 tens, and 5 ones.
- (11) Write the number: 8 thousands, 8 hundreds, 6 tens, and 2 ones.
