



## Convert mL and L

Grade 4

Convert using  $1 \text{ L} = 1,000 \text{ mL}$ .

Multiply by 1,000 to convert Liters (L) to Milliliters (mL). Divide by 1,000 to convert Milliliters (mL) to Liters (L).

**Example:**  $2 \text{ L} = \underline{2,000} \text{ mL}$

(7)  $23 \text{ L} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ mL}$

(8)  $15 \text{ L} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \text{ mL}$
