Find the missing denominator to make fractions equivalent.

Example: $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{10}{\underline{\quad}}$ $\rightarrow 2 \times 5 = 10$, so $3 \times 5 = 15 \rightarrow$ Answer: 15

(11) $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{\underline{\quad}}$

(12) $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{4}{\underline{\quad}}$
