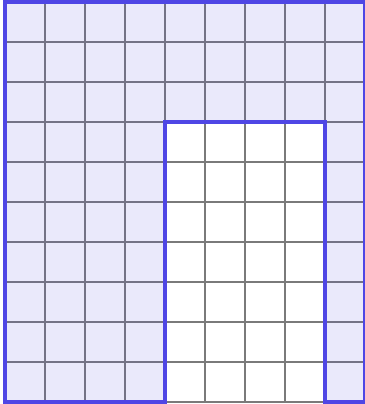

Count unit segments around each rectangle to find perimeter.

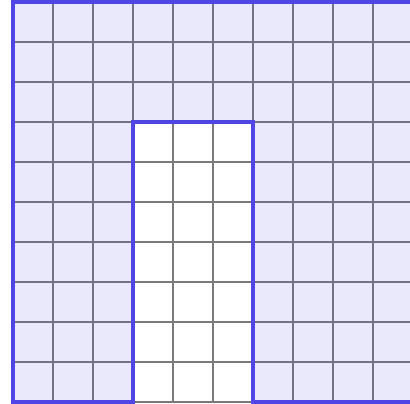
Example: For a 2×3 rectangle: top=3, bottom=3, left=2, right=2. Add them: $3+3+2+2=10$.
