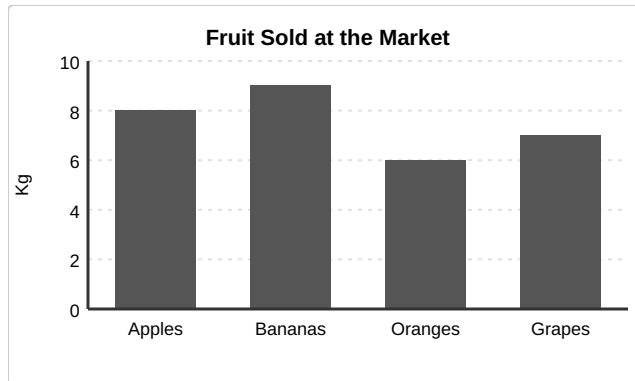

Use the bar graph to answer the questions.

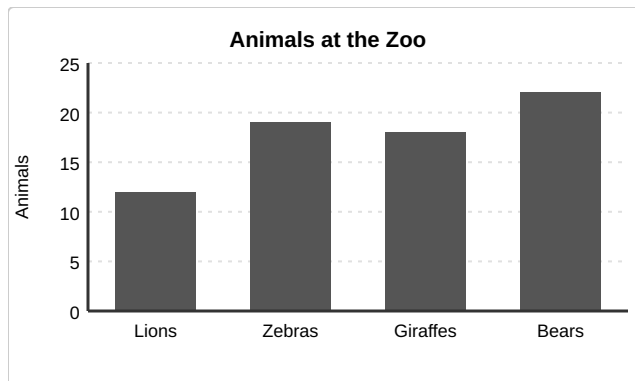
A bar graph uses bars to show data. The height of the bar tells you the number.

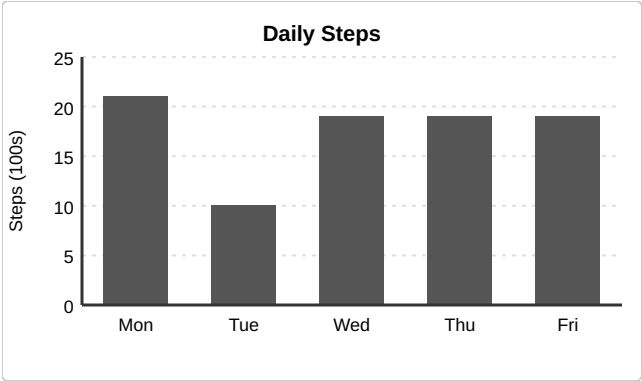
(2) According to the graph, how many animals does "Zebras" have?

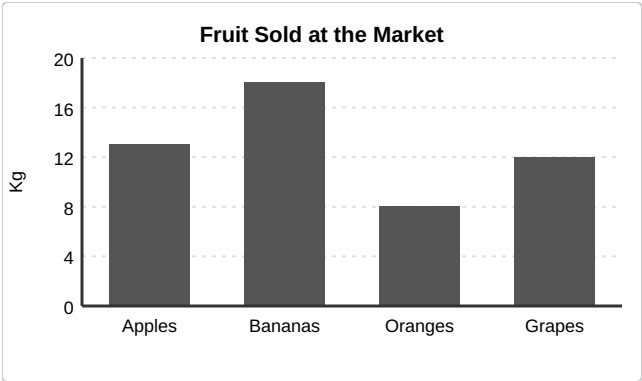


(3) How many more steps (100s) does the highest bar have than the lowest?

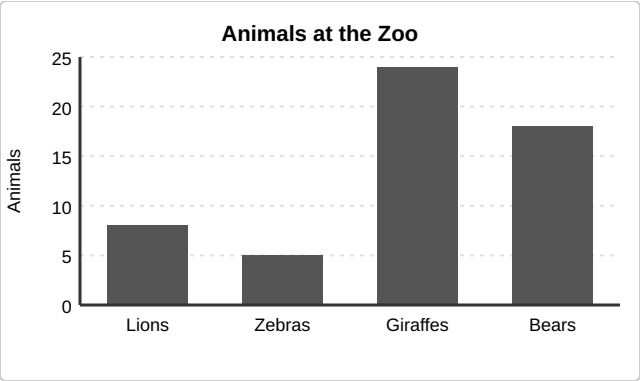
(4) What is the highest value shown in the graph?

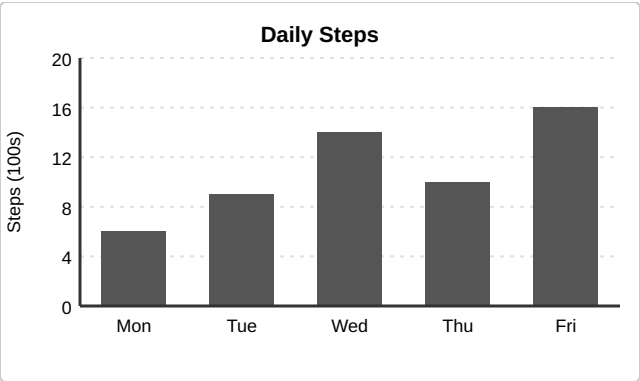
