



Subtract Fraction from Mixed Number

Subtract the fraction from the mixed number.

Example: $2 \frac{4}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$ Ans: $2 \frac{3}{5}$ Solution: (keep whole 2, subtract fractions: $\frac{4}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \frac{3}{5}$)

(1) $4 \frac{2}{3} - \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(2) $6 \frac{3}{4} - \frac{1}{4} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(3) $4 \frac{5}{8} - \frac{1}{8} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(4) $7 \frac{4}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(5) $7 \frac{2}{3} - \frac{1}{3} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(6) $7 \frac{3}{8} - \frac{2}{8} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(7) $4 \frac{5}{8} - \frac{3}{8} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(8) $1 \frac{2}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(9) $4 \frac{3}{5} - \frac{1}{5} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$

(10) $1 \frac{5}{8} - \frac{4}{8} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$



$$(11) \quad 4 \frac{3}{5} - \frac{2}{5} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$

$$(12) \quad 1 \frac{5}{6} - \frac{3}{6} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$$
