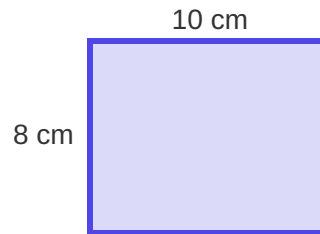

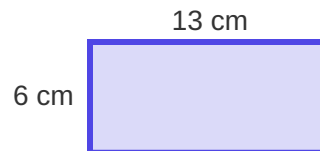
Example: Example: length 9 units, width 4 units $\rightarrow A = 9 \times 4 = 36$ square units.
