- (5) Write the number: 1 hundred-thousand, 2 ten-thousands, 5 thousands, 5 hundreds, 7 tens, and 6 ones.
- (6) Write the number: 5 hundred-thousands, 3 ten-thousands, 5 thousands, 2 hundreds, no tens, and 6 ones.
- (7) Write the number: 2 hundred-thousands, 4 ten-thousands, 5 thousands, 1 hundred, 7 tens, and 2 ones.
