Find the missing number for equivalent fractions.

Example: $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{\underline{\quad}}{10} \rightarrow 2 \times 5 = 10, \text{ so } 1 \times 5 = 5 \rightarrow \text{Answer: } 5$
