Complete the equivalent fraction chains.

Example: $\frac{1}{3} = \frac{3}{\underline{\quad}} = \frac{6}{\underline{\quad}}$ $\rightarrow$ $\times 3: \frac{3}{9}$, $\times 2: \frac{6}{18}$ $\rightarrow$ Answer: $\frac{3}{9}$, $\frac{6}{18}$

(5) $\frac{3}{5} = \frac{9}{\underline{\quad}} = \frac{\underline{\quad}}{25}$

(6) $\frac{4}{5} = \frac{12}{\underline{\quad}} = \frac{\underline{\quad}}{15}$

(7) $\frac{1}{6} = \frac{5}{\underline{\quad}} = \frac{\underline{\quad}}{24}$

(8) $\frac{3}{5} = \frac{9}{\underline{\quad}} = \frac{\underline{\quad}}{10}$
