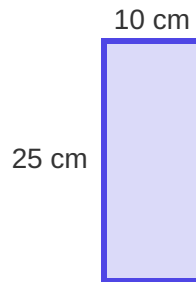

Add length and width, then double the sum.

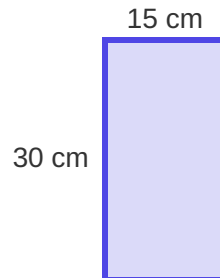
Example: Example: length 7 units, width 3 units $\rightarrow P = 2 \times (7 + 3) = 2 \times 10 = 20$ units.

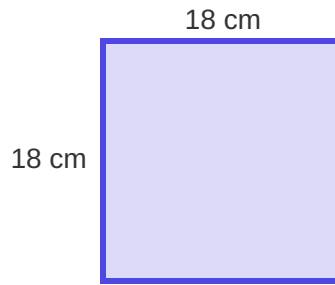

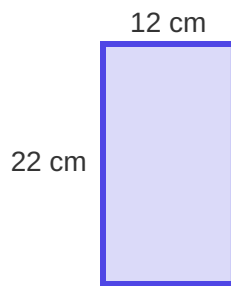

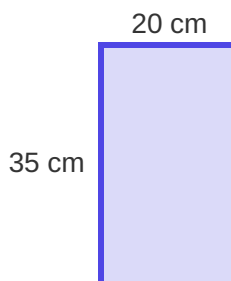

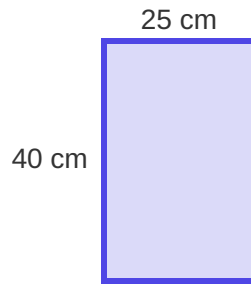

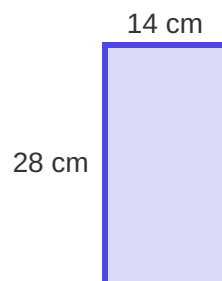

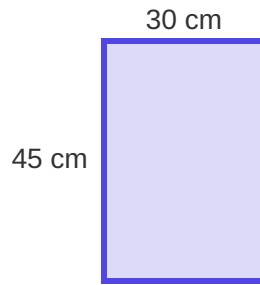
