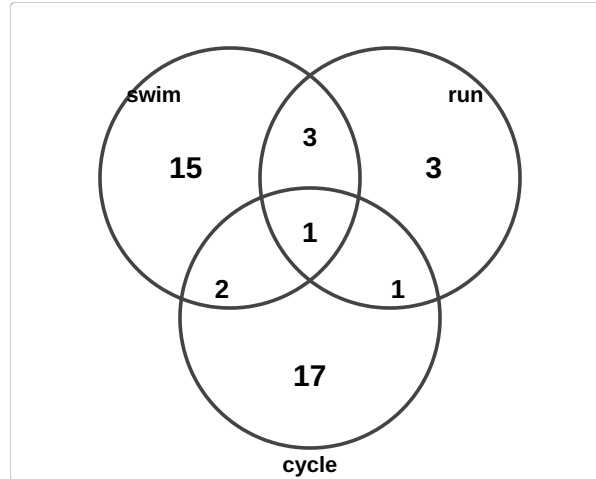

Example: Circle A: 10. Circle B: 12. Circle C: 8. Center (All 3): 2. How many like ALL three? 2

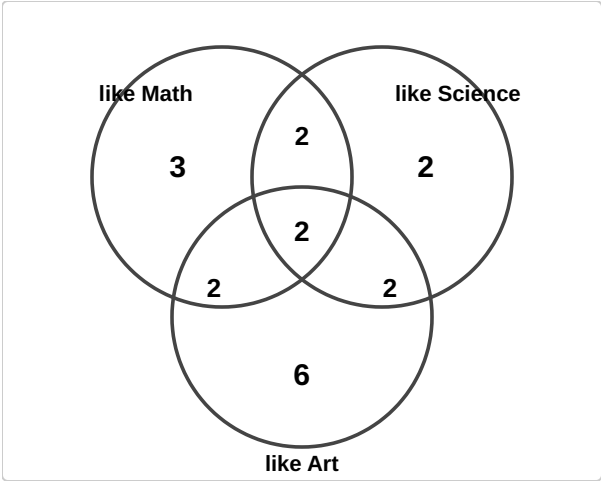

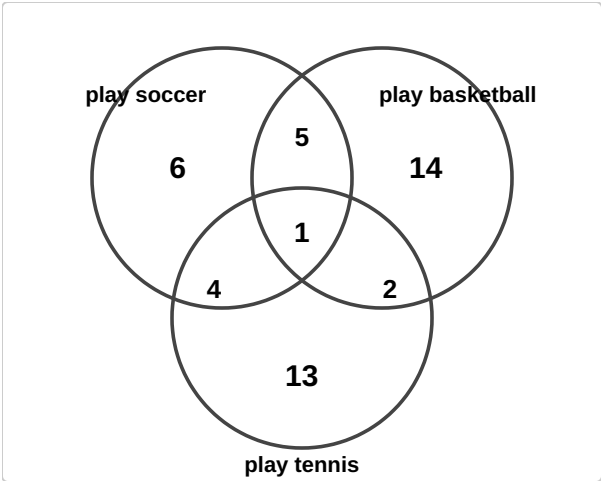

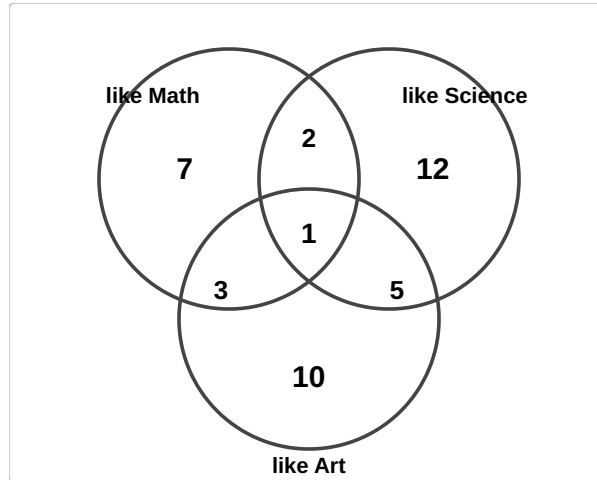

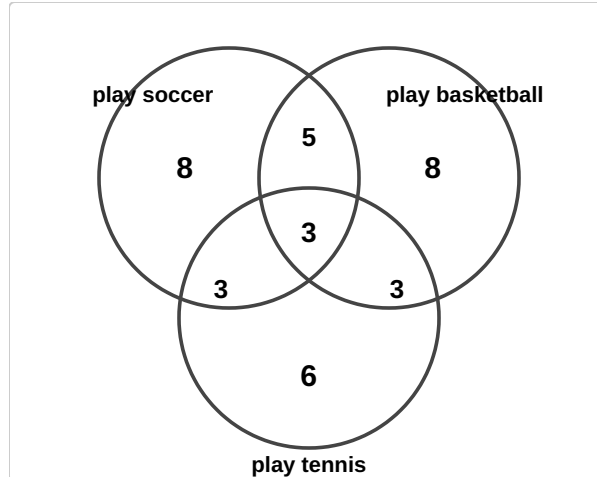

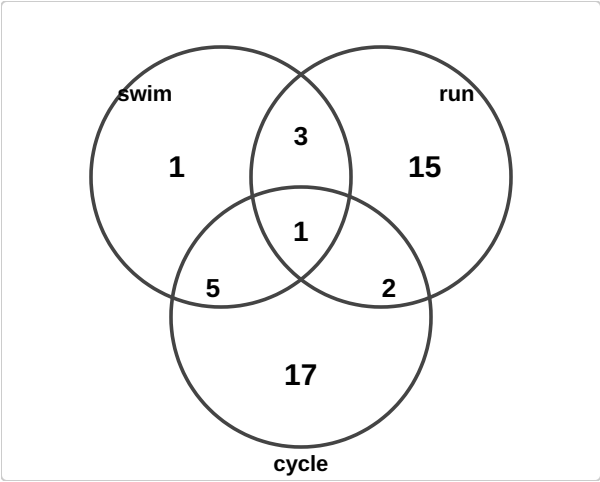

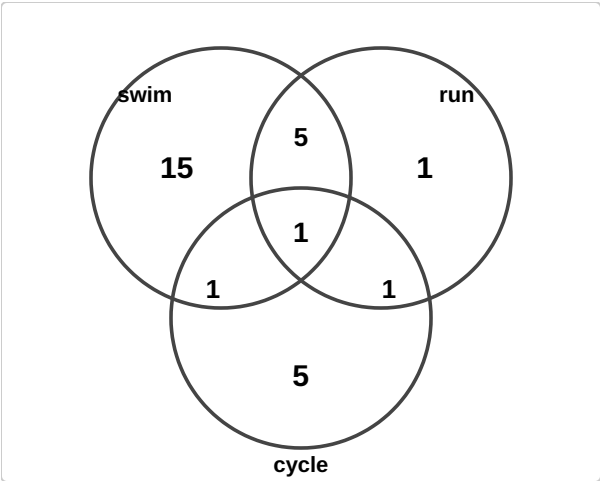

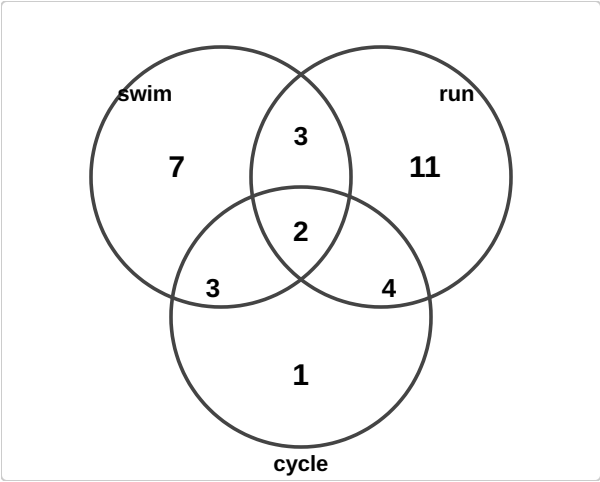

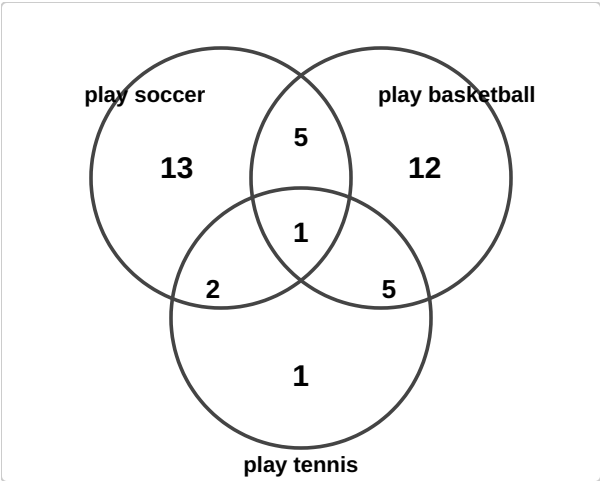

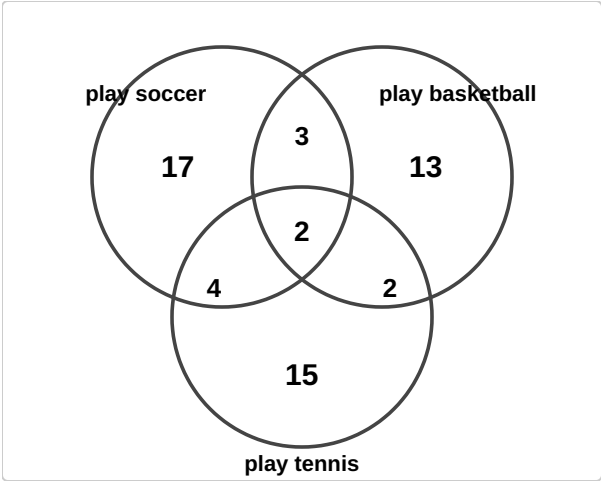

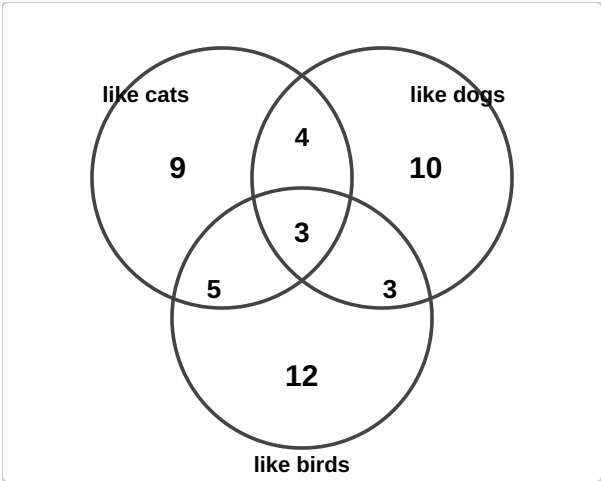

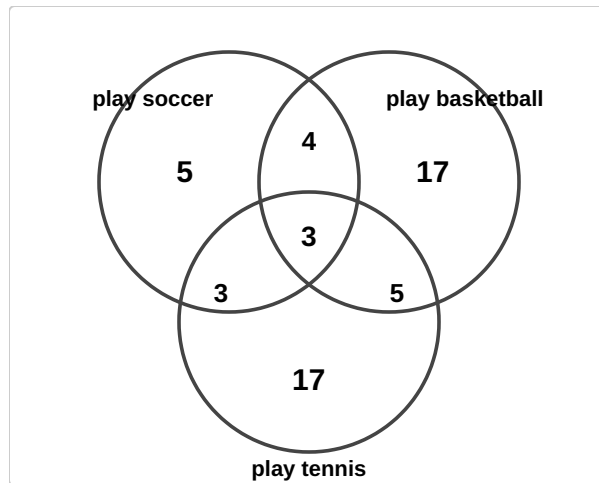
