Choose the correct order of adjectives.

Rule: Quantity → Opinion → Size → Age → Shape → Color → Origin → Material

Adjectives must go in this order. We say "**a big red ball**" — never "**a red big ball**". Try it — the wrong order just sounds odd!

Example: a big red ball ✓ a red big ball ✗

(A) fragrant five pink flowers (B) five pink fragrant flowers (C) five fragrant pink flowers

(6) 🪑 Which phrase correctly describes a chair?

(A) a new green plastic chair (B) a green new plastic chair (C) a new plastic green chair
