- (C) The supreme law of the United States, adopted in 1787, establishing 3 branches of government.
- (D) Home and office of the US President since 1800, located at 1600 Pennsylvania Ave.
- (E) Where Congress meets to make laws, located on Capitol Hill in Washington D.C.
- (F) A 555-foot obelisk in Washington D.C. honoring first president George Washington.
- (G) Has 50 stars for each state and 13 stripes for the original 13 colonies.
- (H) Carved faces of Washington, Jefferson, Roosevelt, and Lincoln in South Dakota.
