- A** This structure in Washington D.C. is 555-feet tall and honors the first president, George Washington.
- B** The official national flower of the United States, designated by Congress in 1986.
- C** An entry point in New York Harbor for over 12 million immigrants between 1892 and 1954.
- D** This document, adopted in 1787, is the supreme law of the United States and sets up the three branches of government.
- E** A pledge of loyalty to the US and its flag, with the phrase 'under God' added in 1954.
- F** Located in Baltimore, MD, a British attack here in 1814 inspired 'The Star-Spangled Banner'.
- G** Faces of four presidents are carved into a mountain in the Black Hills of South Dakota.
- H** Where Congress meets to make laws, located on Capitol Hill in Washington D.C.
